

DENNIS TOWNSHIP HOCKEY – PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT (Adherence is Required)

I will not force my child to participate in organized sports.

I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.

I realize that my child's coach is a volunteer who is generously giving their time to instruct and lead the team and I will therefore do my best to make sure my child attends all practices and games, is on time and has all necessary equipment needed to participate.

I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.

I will never confront a coach right before, during or immediately after a game. If I have a concern, I will take the time to contact the coach and, if needed, arrange for a mutually agreed place and time to speak privately.

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game, practice or youth event.

I will remember that children participate in sports to have fun and that the game is for youths and not for adults.

I will place the emotional and physical wellbeing of the children ahead of any personal desire to win.

I will refrain from using profanity, alcohol or tobacco at all youth events.

I will treat all players, coaches, officials and fellow spectators with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
